

History Bee FAQs



When is the History Bee?

- The Bee is on Friday, March 30, 2012.

Where is the Bee?

- The Bee will be at the Field House on The Frederick Community College campus. If you look at the campus map, it is building "D." FCC is located off of Opossumtown Pike in Frederick.

Where should I park?

- You'll enter the campus through the North entrance – or the second entrance if you're coming from Route 15 – and you're encouraged to park in the first lot on the left, in front of the Visual and Performing Arts Center. The Field House is a short walk along the sidewalk from there.

What time is the Bee?

- Students are expected to register between 10:30 and 11:45 a.m. If you have a sign to hang on the back bleachers, we recommend you get there earlier to set up. The Bee will begin promptly at noon.

Will there be a concessions break?

- We normally plan for one concessions break between the second and final round of competition. However, if the second elimination round goes longer than expected, many times we will skip the formal announcement of a break and continue into the final round. We advise that students arrive early for registration and grab a bite to eat before the event begins at noon.

What sort of concessions will be available?

- The FCC concessions menu normally consists of pizza, nachos, candy, hot dogs, soft drinks, pretzels and other familiar concession items.

What time will the Bee end?

- The Bee normally ends around 3 p.m. at the latest.

What if I have a sign to hang?

- All signs are to be hung on the bleachers towards the back of the gymnasium BEFORE the event begins at noon. We will not be able to provide supplies to hang the sign.
